

## The K-12 Magnet Bill of Rights

- The magnet student enjoys continuous enrollment through the highest grade level in the magnet school where they are accepted to attend as a magnet student.
- The magnet student may be placed on probation only if written notification is received by a parent/guardian at the beginning of the probationary period. The magnet student may be placed on probation only for reasons of academic performance, programmatic performance, programmatic involvement, attendance, or behavior.
- The magnet student who is placed on probation will receive support from the school staff in the area(s) of probation.
- The magnet student who is placed on probation will have a reasonable amount of time to correct the probation deficiencies.
- The magnet student may not be dismissed without written notification to the parent/guardian and a parent/guardian conference with the school principal following a reasonable probationary period. (If a magnet student receives a Level III Code of Conduct infraction, immediate program dismissal may occur without probationary notice or process.)
- The magnet student who is dismissed may appeal the dismissal by submitting a written request for reconsideration with all materials supporting the request, a return address, and a daytime telephone number to:
