
LOST AND FOUND ITEMS



NURSE'S CORNER

IS YOUR CHILD TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

Early in the morning, it is often difficult to make a decision about whether or not your child is sick enough to stay home from school. With minor symptoms, you often cannot tell whether your child is going to get better or worse during the course of the day. Here are some tips to help:

The main reasons for keeping your child home are:

- · Your child's too sick to be comfortable at school.
- Your child might spread a contagious disease to others.

As a rule of thumb a child should stay home if they have:

- A fever (100.4 or greater) in past 24 hours
- Vomited in past 24 hours
- Diarrhea
- · A very frequent cough
- Persistent pain
- A widespread rash

These problems may need to be discussed with your child's pediatrician to determine if an office visit is needed.

When can my child return to school after an illness?

- Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
- Vomit and diarrhea free for 24 hours

The Georgia Foundation for Agriculture Offers \$70,000 in Agriculture-Related Scholarships


Good morning,

The Georgia Foundation for Agriculture is committed to investing in students pursuing careers in agriculture or a related field. For the 2023 year, GFA is offering \$70,000 worth of scholarships. There are several scholarship opportunities available to students, each with varying criteria and eligibility requirements.

The four scholarship categories are:

- Scholarship for Agriculture—10 Scholarships of \$3,000. Like last year, the top 3 ranking applicants will be eligible for an additional \$1,000 bonus.
- <u>Technical College Scholarship for Agriculture</u>—4 Scholarships of \$1,500. This year, the top 2 ranking applicants will be eligible for an additional \$500 bonus.
- Rising College Junior/Senior Scholarship for Agriculture—10 Scholarships of \$2,000
- UGA College of Veterinary Medicine Scholarship—2 Scholarships of \$5,000


ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITY
