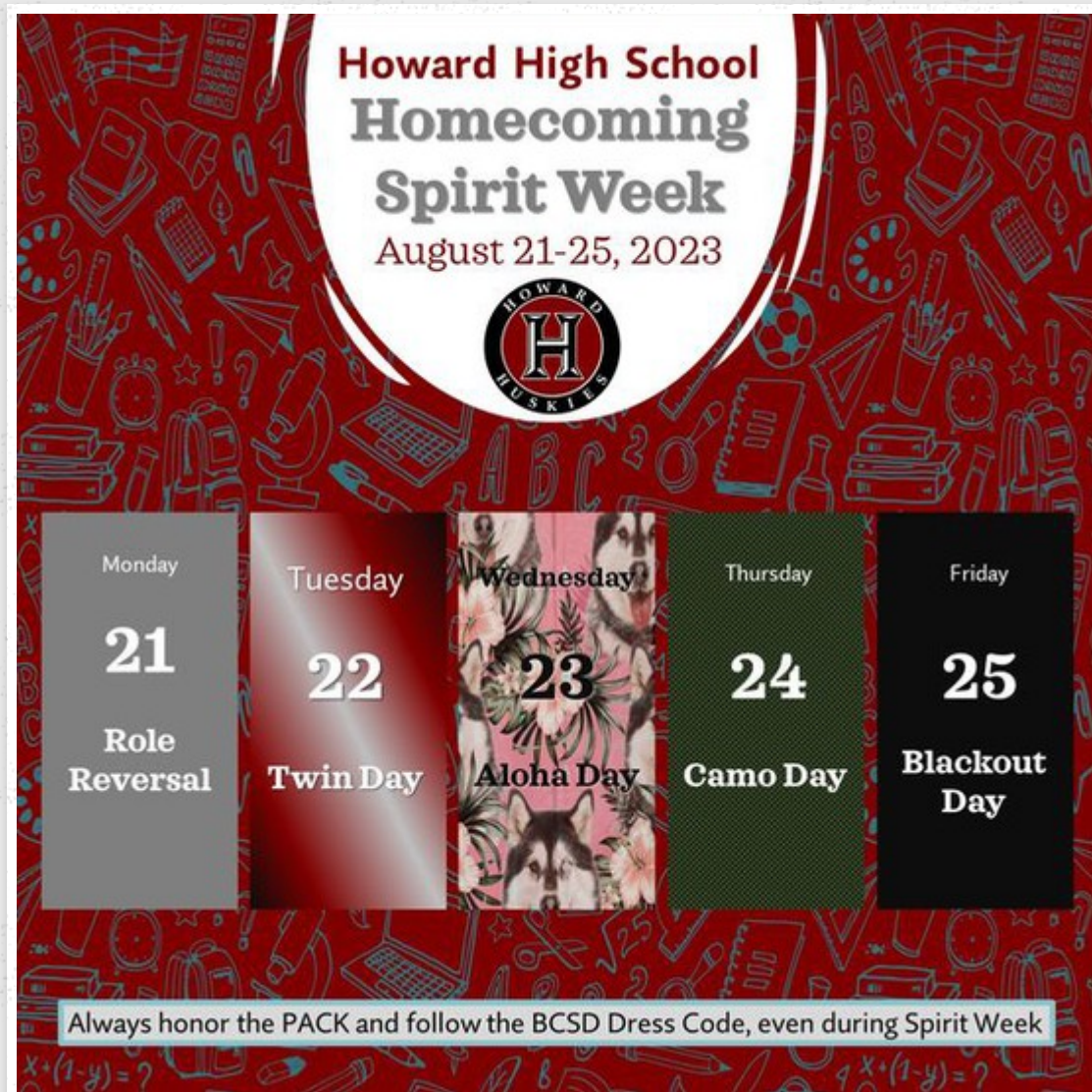

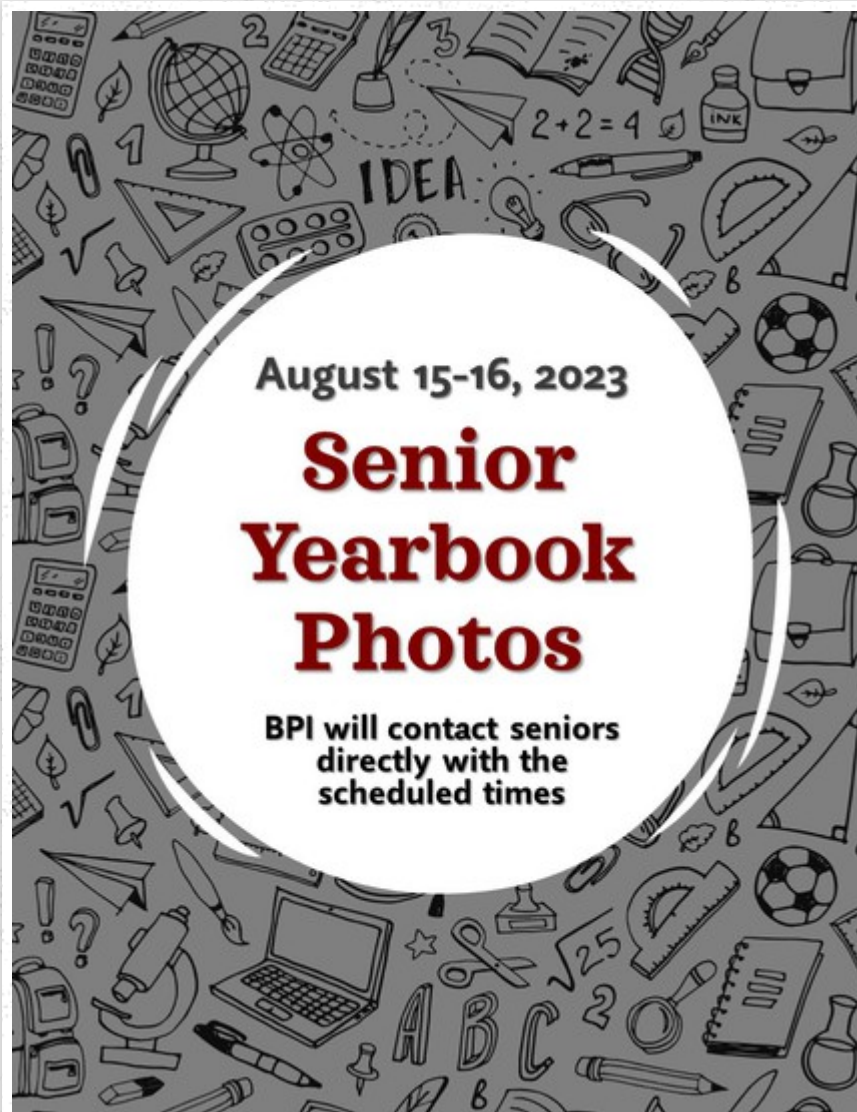

SELF-CARE CORNER

As we "Breathe for Beginnings" this first month of school, take the time to check out the free resources at www.breatheforchange.com/resources that are designed for teachers. There are free classes available and a blog that offers many strategies to incorporate SEL into your classroom.

Below is a simple meditative breathing exercise that you can do anytime you need more than a quick breath break.

Put on some relaxing music and sit or lie down so that you are comfortable.

1. Take a deep breath: inhale and then exhale.
2. Gently close your eyes (not before you finish reading this though!)
3. Focus your mind on a place you love. Somewhere that brings you joy, happiness, and peace.
4. Then, slowly...imagine how it sounds...looks...smells...tastes...feels...when you are actually there

5. Now put all of these sensations together and let your mind explore and wander through the experience.
6. Breathe...In and out...Take a few moments to soak up the feeling of being in that place you love.
7. When you are ready, slowly return to where you are and open your eyes.
8. To seal the practice, place one hand on your heart and the other one on top and take 3 deep breaths of gratitude.

LAPTOP INFORMATION AND CARE

•Students are not allowed to use personal devices at school. All students must use a school issued device during the school to complete assignments. Visit the media center to check out a laptop if you do not have a school issued device. Remember to bring your charged laptop to school daily and keep up with your charger!

*Always keep your laptop closed when you need to walk with your laptop and it's not in the carrying case.

•Never carry your laptop while open or lift the laptop by the screen/monitor! Handling your laptop in this manner can damage your screen.

•Do not place paper/objects between your keyboard and monitor, it will crack your screen!

•Keep drinks and liquids away from your computer. A spill can damage the hard drive and the motherboard. These type of damages may cost the same price as a new laptop to replace, Please be careful!

MEDIA CENTER SERVICES

The Media Center welcomes Huskies to the 2023-2024 School Year! We have checked out the majority of our student laptops with the exception of students who did not have an English Language Arts Class or did not attend school on the first day of school. Students who enroll on any date after August 1, 2023, it takes 24 hours and sometimes 48 hours before the media center is able to check out a laptop to the student. If the student does not have a line of enrollment and are not in Infinite Campus, they will not have access to a computer. Please also understand that it may also take some time to see classes in Canvas after receiving a line of enrollment.

Library books may be checked out from the media center after reviewing the Media Center Orientation and Digital Citizenship PowerPoint. The PowerPoint will be shared with teachers beginning Thursday, August 17, 2023.

Students may sit in the media center after arriving to school from 7:05 a.m. -7:25 a.m. The media center also welcomes students during each lunch period, no eating or drinking while in the media center. Please go to the cafeteria if you need to eat. Cell phones, ear buds, and personal devices are not allowed.

- To avoid disqualification, each essay **MUST** include the **student's first and last name, parent's name and phone number, and their school's name.**

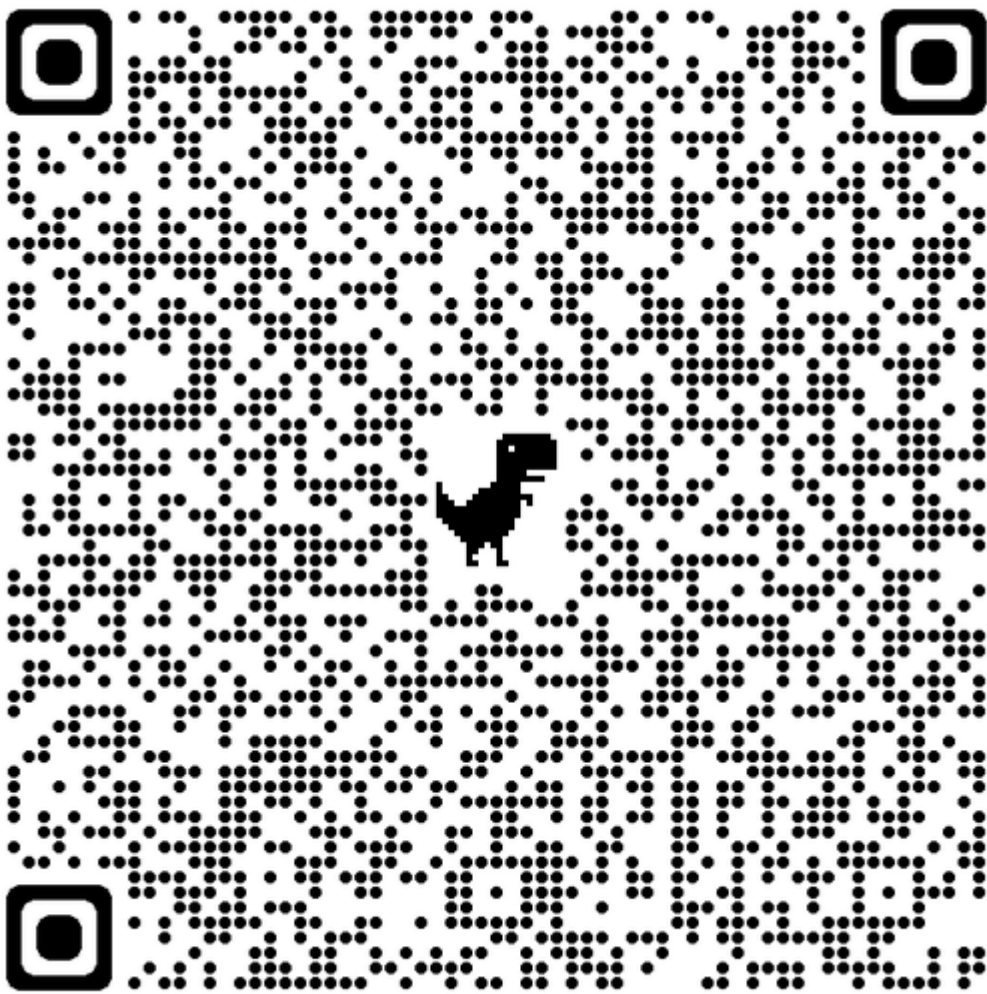
