

Prom 2024 Rules, Regulations, and General Information

The 2024 Howard High School Prom is almost here! The Class of 2025 has done an excellent job selecting this "On the Red Carpet" in honor of our senior class. In preparation for this wonderful event, it is imperative that you review the following information and guidelines.

The 2024 Howard High School Prom will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024 at The Anderson Conference Center; 5171 Eisenhower Pkwy Ste D, Macon, GA 31206 from 6pm to 11pm. Senior Walk-out begins at 6:30pm.

The Prom Guest Request Form, Acknowledgement of Prom Rules, and Regulations form (this form) and Prom Dress Approval form must be signed and submitted to Mrs. Stubbs by April 4, 2021. A copy of these forms can be found in the front office or in media center. An email with these forms will also be sent to you.

Guests

- A Prom Guest Request Form must be submitted and pre-approved for any guest that does not attend Howard High School. Guests will be required to show photo identification at prom.
- Guests must be at least in 11th or 12th grade and no older than 20.
- The person who invited the guest will be held responsible for their guest's behavior.

Access to the Venue

- Access to prom will begin at 6:00pm.
- When entering the venue, students and their guests will be given a wristband. If you leave the venue, then the armband is taken off, and you will not be allowed to re-enter.
- Students and guests whose names are not on the guest list will not be admitted to the venue.

Student and Guest Behavior

- Students and guests are expected to behave in a manner befitting for a school function.
- These items are banned from prom: drugs, alcohol, weapons, tobacco, and vaping devices of any kind.
- Lewd dances and/or behavior is unacceptable at prom.
- Students and/or guests may be asked to leave if they violate the rules.

Dress and Attire

- All dresses must be approved by Mrs. Stubbs by April 4,2024. This includes guest attire. See QR Code on the attire form and or Attire PowerPoint Presentation. Click here: HHS Prom 2024 Attire Presentation
- If you or your guest show up in an unapproved, inappropriate dress, you will be refused admittance to prom. Please see the Prom Attire Approval form for more guidelines.

Prom 2024 Attire Guidelines and Approval Form

Juniors and Seniors, prom is a very special and elegant night. In an effort to create a memorable and dignified evening of which we can be proud, we are asking that your attire reflects the maturity of the graduating classes of 2024 and 2025. Howard High School students and their guests must follow the guidelines below. All dresses must be approved by Mrs. Stubbs by April 4th.

This is a FORMAL event that calls for formal attire. This includes tuxedos, suits (jacket, tie, dress shirt and slacks), military dress uniforms, and formal dresses.

- Jeans, t-shirts, and sweatpants are NOT allowed.
- All clothing should fit properly (not too tight and not too loose).
- Dresses should not be shorter than fingertip length. This includes slits in the dress.
- The back of the dress should not be lower than the natural waistline. (no showing the belly button).
- Dresses may be strapless (if they fit properly) or include spaghetti straps.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- No bandanas, chains, or canes, No baseball caps, and no grills
- Bare midriffs and plunging necklines are not allowed. No cut outs. Two-piece top/skirt, outfits must cover midriff.
- No see-through material that exposes midriff, excessive cleavage, or thighs.
- Collared dress shirt with long sleeves, worn with a tie/bow tie (exception: tux shirt with a decorative button). Shirts must remain on & tucked in for the entire dance.
- No sagging.
